



The 1st Elementary School of Alexandria is a public school in a Provincial town of Northern Greece. It was founded in 1956. The stone building's traditional architecture, as well as its courtyard area of 6 acres make it a jewel of the city. We are next to the legendary Mt Olympus and the ancient city of Vergina, the homeland of Alexander the Great, where you can visit the Royal Tomb Of King Philip of Macedonia, Father of Alexander the Great.

Our 220 students are children of rural families, some of whom are Muslims, Roma and Albanians. Additionally, over the last few years refugee students have been added to the student body.

We participate in 4 European programs Erasmus plus, two of those are in KA1, one in KA201 and one in KA227. We have also participated in the European Project H2020: "Open Schools for Open Societies - OSOS" and we continue our collaborations in twinning projects.

This year, after quality and strict evaluation of our application, we were awarded the Erasmus Accreditation with code 2020-1-EL01- KA120-SCH-094631 in the framework of Key Action 1 of the new program (2021-2027) in the field of School Education.

We consider European programs to offer the opportunity to adjust and upgrade the role of teachers, students and overall the school unit, based on the triptych knowledge - skills - attitudes.

Our goal and vision is the transformation of our school into a modern and open learning space, in the hope that it will be possible to Implement innovations and that will transform the culture of our Students, teachers but also the wider society on the school concept.
